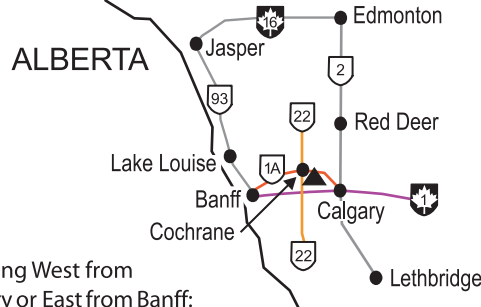
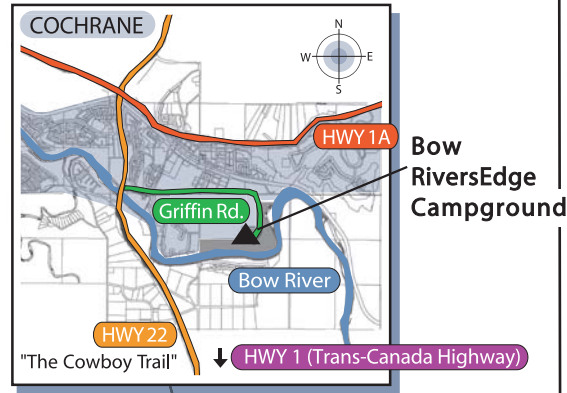

The Rocky Mountains provide numerous adventures at any time during the year. Explore the hiking and biking trails in our national parks in the summer, and in the winter try snowboarding, downhill skiing, or even take a dog sled ride!

In any season, you can also take a drive on the Cowboy Trail, which stretches 700 kilometres from Cardston on the U.S. border, all the way north to Mayerthorpe.

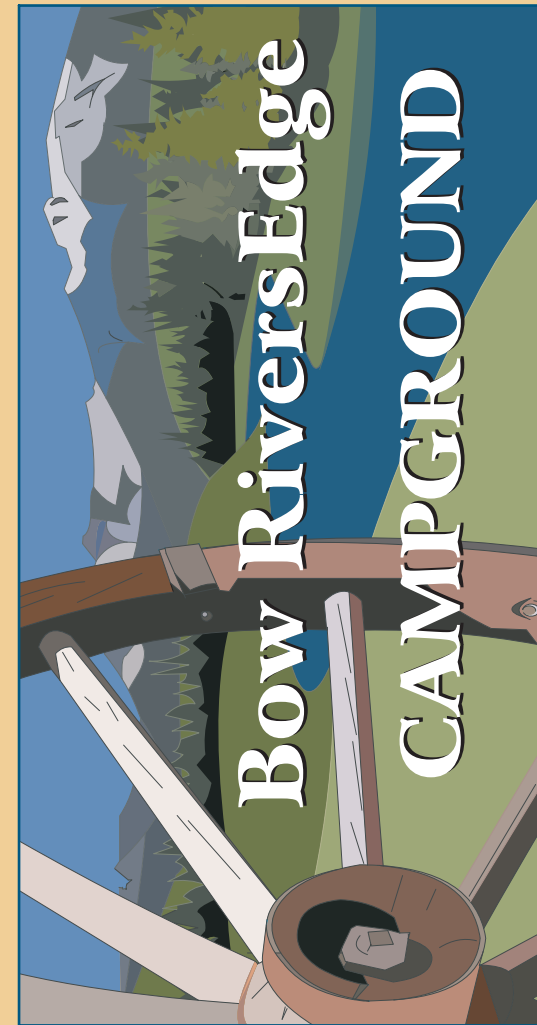

- Off Season: central facilities and power available

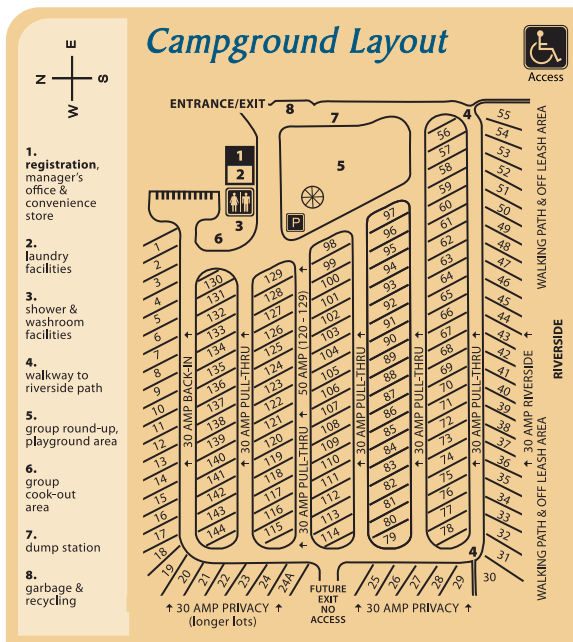
